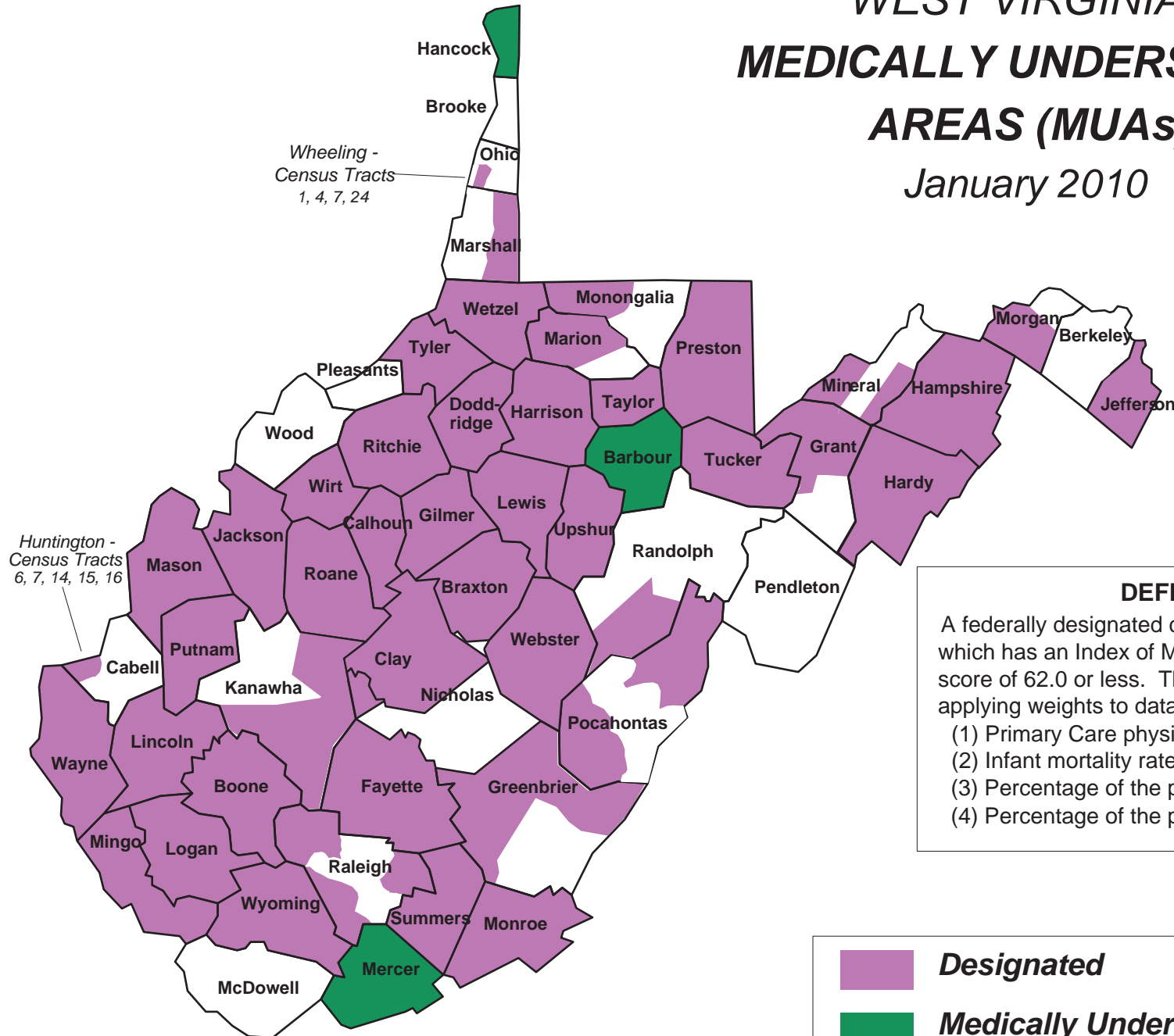


WEST VIRGINIA MEDICALLY UNDERSERVED AREAS (MUAs) January 2010



DEFINITION:

A federally designated county or sub-county area which has an Index of Medical Underservice (IMU) score of 62.0 or less. The IMU score is obtained by applying weights to data on the following indicators:

- (1) Primary Care physicians per 1,000 population
- (2) Infant mortality rate
- (3) Percentage of the population 65 or >
- (4) Percentage of the population below poverty level
